

SOUTH KINGSTOWN SCHOOL DEPARTMENT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS- 2017

Currently, students must receive the following immunizations, physical exams, etc.

prior to their enrollment for KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 12

RI Department of Health Requirements effective August 1, 2015

PRE-SCHOOL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● DTaP-4 doses ● HepB- 3 doses ● Polio-3 doses ● PCV- 4 doses ● HIB-3 doses ● MMR-1 dose ● Varicella-1 dose ● Proof of Lead Screening ● Copy of Physical Exam within the past 12 months or appointment within 6 months of entering school
KINDERGARTEN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● DTaP- 5 doses (Final dose after 4 y.o.) ● HepB -3 doses (Final dose after 6-months old) ● Polio- 4 doses (Final dose after 4-years old) ● MMR -2 doses ● Varicella- 2 doses or proof from your child's doctor stating that your child has a history of chickenpox disease ● Proof of Lead Screening ● Proof of Vision Screening ● Copy of 5 year old Physical Exam within the past 12 months or appointment within 6 months of entering school
Children 10 years and older- TB Screening requirement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All children born out of the US must provide proof of a negative PPD or blood test ● All children known to travel outside the U.S. for greater than 90 days, should have a negative PPD test (done in the U.S.) or blood test ● Anyone with a positive PPD, must have a negative Chest x-ray ● Any child with a BCG may opt for a chest x-ray rather than a PPD ● Results of all screening tests for TB must be submitted and reviewed by the school nurse teacher prior to entry into school
SEVENTH (7th) GRADE, EIGHTH (8th) GRADE and NINTH (9TH) Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● DTap -5 doses (Final dose after 4 y.o.) ● HepB -3 doses (Final dose after 6-months old) ● Polio- 4 doses (Final dose after 4-years old) ● MMR-2 doses ● Varicella- 2 doses or proof from your child's doctor stating that your child has a history of chickenpox disease. ● Tdap One (1) dose at 7th grade entry ● MCV One (1) dose at 7th grade entry ● HPV - 1 dose at 7th grade entry, 2 doses at 8th grade entry, depending on age at onset of series and dose spacing, ● HPV - 3rd dose at 9th grade entry may be required ● Copy of Physical Exam within the past 12 months or appointment within 6 months of entering school
TWELFTH (12TH) GRADE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Evidence of all of the above 7th,8th and 9th grade requirements ● Booster dose of MCV for entry into 12th grade (CDC recommends booster at age 16) ● Copy of Physical Exam when student turns sixteen (16) years of age, and no later than 6 months after the student enters the 12th grade
