Needs Assessment

Our needs assessment revealed that our staff and students take pride in being a member of our school

community. We determined that focus areas will be in the areas of ELA, Mathematics and Social Emotional Learning. We will focus on improving Mathematics and ELA RICAS scores:

- ELA: percentage of students scoring "Met Expectations" or "Exceeded Expectations" = 60.8%
- MTH: percentage of students scoring "Met Expectations" or "Exceeded Expectations" = 67.1%
- SEL: students at "moderate risk" or "high risk" in the SOCIAL BEHAVIOR category of universal screener = 6%

Therefore, we have selected the following main priorities for this academic year: ELA improvement,

math improvement, and SEL improvement.

1. We will increase the overall percentage of students scoring "Met Expectations" or "Exceeded Expectations" on the 2022 RICAS Mth Assessment by 10% (67.1% RICAS ELA 2022 increasing to 73.8% on RICAS Mth 2023)

Initiative 1: Weekly MTSS

Action Step 1: Create MTSS weekly schedule in the building

Action Step 2: Create and implement norms, expectations, agendas, progress monitoring schedule

Action Step 3: During CPT, teachers will use a protocol to unpack math instructional strategies.

Assessments results will drive the adjustment of instruction based on student needs. A district wide tool will be implemented.

Initiative 2: Professional Development

Action Step 1: Create schedule and implement

Action Step 2: Workshop model will be fulling implemented in all math blocks.
