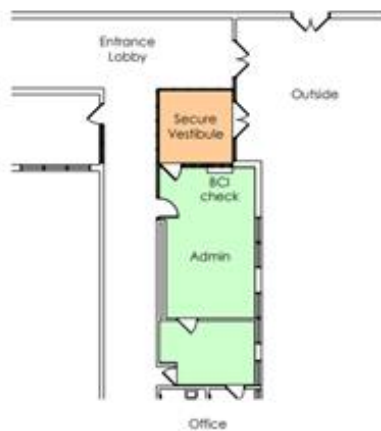
SAFE, SECURE & HEALTHY SCHOOLS PROJECT

Student and staff safety are of the highest importance to ensure an environment that cultivates learning and growth. In order to provide safety precautions for our schools, we have determined that security upgrades were needed at a number of our schools. The project includes front door vestibule hardening and upgraded security systems at South Kingstown High School, Broad Rock Middle School, Peace Dale Elementary School, Wakefield Elementary School, West Kingstown Elementary School and Matunuck Elementary School.

- Increase student and staff safety by creating a single secure entry point.
- Integration and repositioning of existing cameras to reinforce security at secure entrance

KEY PROJECT STATISTICS
